- Informing and advocating in media, with politicians, government agencies, the private sector and community organisations

- Organising and presenting at conferences, roundtables and seminars
- Publishing resources such as our journal *Around The House*, policy briefs and analysis, Shelter NSW eBulletins, factsheets on NSW and Australian housing
